Geoengineering and Weather Modification Activities

In accordance with Section 403.4115, Florida Statutes, the FDOT Aviation Office requires all operators of public-use airports to report the physical presence and the landing, takeoff, stopover, or refueling of any aircraft equipped with any part, component, device, or the like which may be used to support the intentional emission, injection, release, or dispersion of air contaminants into the atmosphere within the borders of this state when such emissions occur for the express purpose of affecting the temperature, weather, climate, or the intensity of sunlight.
